

St. Clair Avenue West Transit Improvements Project

Phase 3: Vaughan Road to Westmount Avenue

Partial Intersection Closure St. Clair Avenue West and Alberta Avenue

Start Date: 7:00 a.m. Wednesday, April 15, 2009*

End Date: 4:00 p.m. Thursday, April 23, 2009*

St. Clair/Alberta Intersection

Beginning at 7:00 am on Wednesday, April 15 to 4:00 pm on Thursday, April 23, 2009 a partial road closure will be required at the intersection of St. Clair/Alberta Avenue to accommodate track construction activity through the intersection.

During the partial closure, one lane of traffic along St. Clair Ave. in both directions will remain open, allowing vehicles to travel through the intersection. However, traffic travelling on Alberta Avenue in either direction will not be able to cross the intersection. The partial closure of the intersection will also temporarily prohibit left-hand turns in all directions. TTC service will be maintained on St Clair Avenue during this intersection work.

In this stage of the intersection work, the activities will involve;

- Removal of the existing track
- Excavation of the track area
- Pouring of new concrete foundation slab and electrical installations. This intersection will be made into a signalized intersection.
- Rails installed
- Concrete poured to form structure below grade
- Concrete poured to form the track roadway surface.

Details

- The work in the intersection will begin shortly after the traffic restrictions have been put into place.
- Safety measures such as barrier fences will be in place.
- A temporary pedestrian wooden walkway/bridge will be placed at an excavated section of the intersection to maintain north/south pedestrian crossing.
- A police officer will be on-site during the work to assist with traffic and pedestrian movement.
- Pedestrian sidewalk traffic and access to businesses will be maintained during the construction.

Traffic Restrictions

Eastbound St. Clair:	One lane of traffic maintained through the intersection. Left turn not permitted.
Westbound St. Clair:	One lane of traffic maintained through the intersection. Left turn not permitted.
Northbound Alberta:	Only north-to-east right turn maintained. Traffic not permitted through the intersection..
Southbound Alberta:	Only south-to-west right turn maintained. Traffic not permitted through the intersection.

Work Hours

Streetcar track construction is a 24-hour operation. All heavy construction work will take place between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m., Monday to Friday. Weekend work will take place when required. Overnight work includes delivery of rail, rail installation and rail welding.

Other Track Construction

After work is completed at the intersection, excavation of the track area will continue west to Westmount Avenue.

Parking

No on-street parking will be available in the work zones until track reconstruction is completed; however, limited parking will be made available at certain locations, providing it does not interfere with construction.

Getting Around on the TTC during Construction

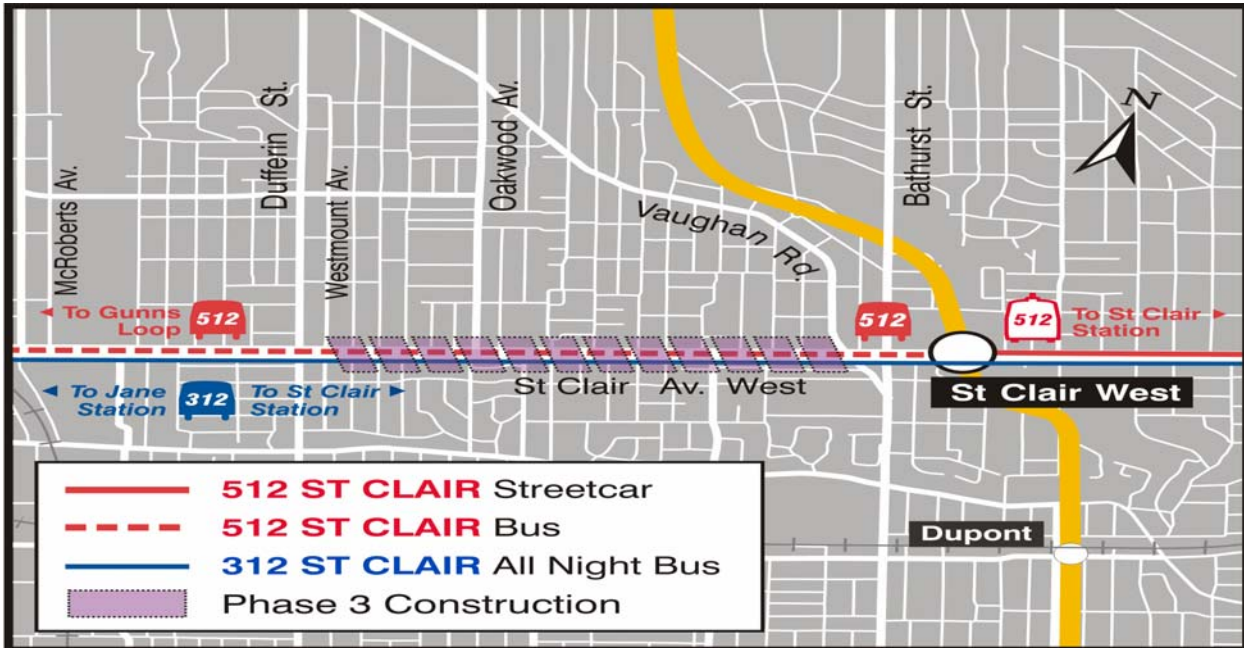
512/312 St. Clair Route: The transit map below shows the bus and streetcar transit service currently provided on St. Clair Avenue West.

- 512 St. Clair buses are operating on St. Clair Avenue between Gunns Loop at Keele Street and St. Clair West Station at Bathurst Street.

- 512 St. Clair streetcars are operating between St. Clair West Station and St. Clair Station at Yonge Street.
- 312 St. Clair Night buses are operating along regular routing from Jane Station at Bloor Street to the St. Clair Station at Yonge Street.

Note: Buses will continue to operate on the western portion of the 512 St. Clair route as construction of the right-of-way continues in 2009.
