St. Clair/Oakwood Intersection

Beginning at 6:00 a.m. on **Friday, August 7, 2009** to 7:00 a.m. on **Monday, August 10, 2009** a partial road closure will be required at the intersection of St. Clair/Oakwood to accommodate reconstruction of the;

- Eastbound curb lane through the intersection
- Roadway on Oakwood Avenue, south from the intersection approximately 10 meters in length
- Sidewalk and curb at the southwest and southeast corners of the intersection.

Note: During this intersection work, buses on the 63-316 OSSINGTON and 161 ROGERS routes will be diverted both ways. (See details below and map on reverse side).

Traffic Restrictions

Eastbound St. Clair: One lane of traffic maintained through the intersection. No southbound turns permitted

Westbound St. Clair: One lane of traffic maintained through the intersection. No southbound turns permitted.

Northbound Oakwood: Closed at construction limit approaching the St Clair intersection. Local access maintained.

Southbound Oakwood: Only right and left turns permitted at the St. Clair intersection.

Details

- Work to the south curb lane at the intersection will begin after the traffic restrictions have been put into place.
- Safety measures such as barrier fences will be in place.
- A police officer will be on-site during the work to assist with traffic and pedestrian movement.
- Pedestrian sidewalk traffic and access to businesses will be maintained during the construction.

Parking

No on-street parking will be available in the work zones until roadway reconstruction is completed.

Getting Around on the TTC during Construction

512/312 ST. CLAIR Route: The transit map on the reverse shows the bus and streetcar transit service currently provided on St. Clair Avenue West.

- 512 St. Clair buses are operating on St. Clair Avenue between Gunns Loop at Keele Street and St. Clair West Station at Bathurst Street.
- 512 St. Clair streetcars are operating between St. Clair West Station and St. Clair Station at Yonge Street.
- 312 St. Clair Night buses are operating along regular routing from Jane Station at Bloor Street to the St. Clair Station at Yonge Street.

Note: Buses will continue to operate on the western portion of the 512 St. Clair route as construction of the right-of-way continues in 2009.

63-316 OSSINGTON and 161 ROGERS Bus Routes: From 6 a.m. Friday, August 7 to 7 a.m. Monday, August 10.

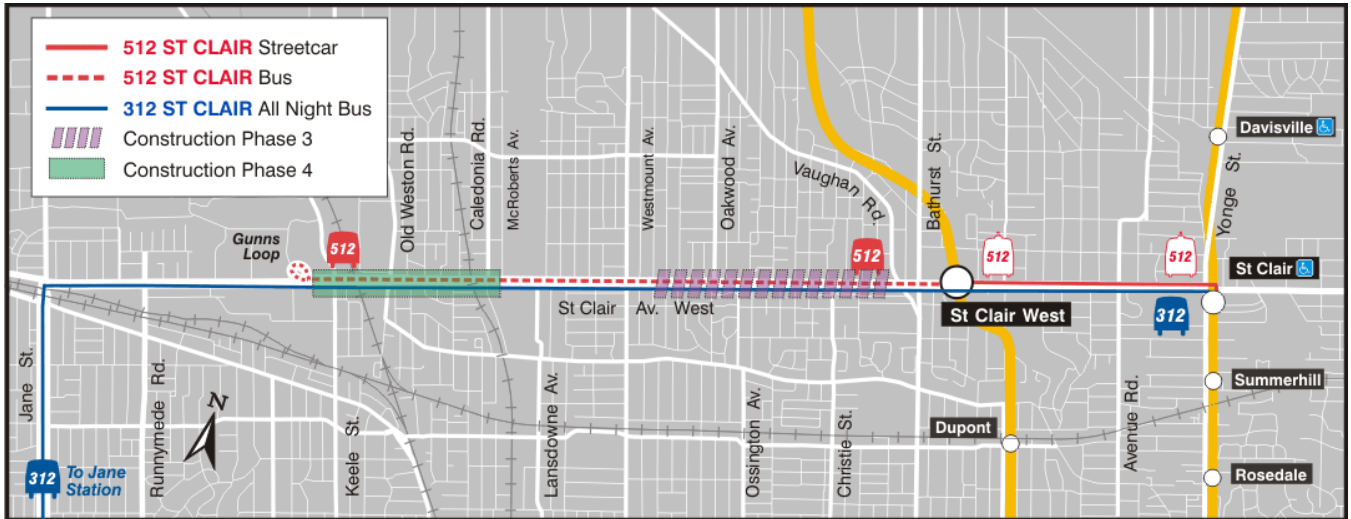
NORTHBOUND: From Davenport Road; north on Oakwood Avenue, west on Rosemount Avenue, north on Glenholme Avenue, east on Conway Avenue and north on Oakwood Avenue to route.

SOUTHBOUND: From Rogers Road; south on Oakwood Avenue, east on Glenhurst Avenue, south on Winona Drive, east on St. Clair Avenue, south on Christie Street, west on Davenport Road and south on Ossington Avenue to route.

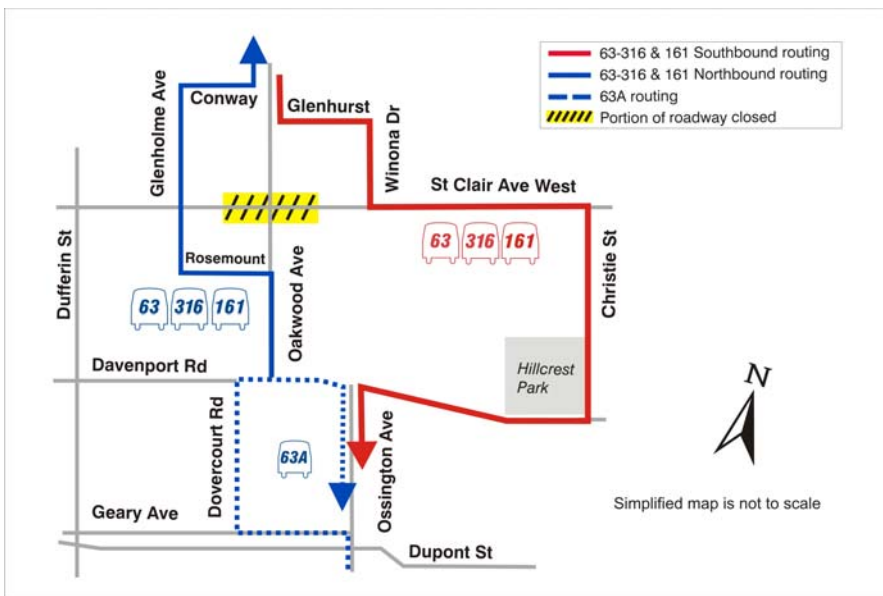
63"A" OSSINGTON Bus Route: From 6 a.m. Friday, August 7 to 7 a.m. Monday, August 10.

From Ossington Station; north on Ossington Avenue, west on Geary Avenue, north on Dovercourt Road, east on Davenport Road and south on Ossington Avenue to route.
