

## St. Clair Avenue West Transit Improvements Project

### Ford Street and St. Clair Avenue West Intersection Partial Closure for Roadway Reconstruction

**Start: Monday, August 31, 2009 - 7:00 a.m.\***

**End: Friday, September 4, 2009 - 7:00 a.m.\***

\* Timeline is subject to change due to unforeseen events. Content is accurate and current at time of printing.

Beginning at 7:00 a.m. on Monday, **August 31** to 7:00 a.m. on Friday, **September 4**, reconstruction of the Ford Street and St. Clair Avenue West intersection will require a partial road closure of Ford Street at St. Clair.

#### Details

- Reconstruction of eastbound curb lane thorough the intersection.
- Reconstruction of southeast and southwest corners of the intersection; including curb and sidewalk.
- Pavement removal,
- Pouring of the concrete base
- placing the asphalt base

Safety measures such as barrier fences will be in place surrounding the construction zone. Pedestrian sidewalk traffic and pedestrian access to businesses will be maintained during the construction.

#### Traffic Restrictions

- **St. Clair Avenue West:** A minimum of one lane of traffic along St. Clair Avenue will remain open in both directions, allowing vehicles to travel through the intersection. No southbound turns permitted.
- **Northbound Ford Street** will be maintained for local traffic only, north of Connolly Street / Davenport Road with no access to St Clair.
- **Southbound Ford Street:** no turns will be permitted from St. Clair southbound onto Ford Street. (Ford Street will be closed on the south side of St Clair).

#### Work Hours

Work will generally take place from 7:00a.m. to 7:00 p.m, Monday to Friday with weekend work and overnight work as required. Efforts will be made to minimize noise as much as possible.

#### Deliveries

During construction, deliveries to the front of businesses within the work zone may need to be coordinated with the on-site City inspector.

#### Recycling and Garbage Collection

Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move the items to an appropriate location and return the bins/containers. Please label your bins/containers with your address.

#### Parking

No on-street parking will be available in the work zones until the reconstruction work is completed; however, limited parking will be made available at certain locations, providing it does not interfere with construction.
