

# St. Clair Avenue West Transit Improvements Project

## Laughton Ave. and St. Clair Ave. W Intersection Closure for Roadway Reconstruction

**Start:** Wednesday, September 2 - 6:00 a.m. \*

**Completion:** Saturday, September 5 - 5:00 p.m. \*

### Laughton Ave. / St. Clair Ave. W Intersection Roadway Reconstruction:

**Beginning at 6:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 2 to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 5** reconstruction of the roadway will require a partial road closure at the intersection of St. Clair Ave. West and Laughton Ave.

#### Details

- Complete excavation of the roadway area; pouring of concrete for a new road base;
- Safety measures such as barrier fences will be in place surrounding the construction zone. Pedestrians will be required to walk around the fences.
- North/south pedestrian crossing will be maintained.
- A police officer will be on-site during the work to assist with traffic and pedestrian movement.
- Delivery of materials associated with this work will be on-going.
- Pedestrian sidewalk traffic and pedestrian access to businesses will be maintained during the construction.

#### Traffic Restrictions - St. Clair Avenue

One eastbound and westbound traffic lane will be maintained on St. Clair Avenue West through the Laughton Ave. intersection.

#### Traffic Restrictions – Laughton Ave.

The roadway will be completely closed at St. Clair W for any traffic movement.

#### Work Hours

Roadway reconstruction in the intersection will be completed on a continuous 24-hour basis. Working around-the-clock is a necessity in order to complete the intersection work quickly. During the construction, noise should be expected. However, the loudest work, such as saw-cutting and the breaking of concrete will be restricted to the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

#### Deliveries

During construction, deliveries to the front of businesses within the work zone may need to be coordinated with the on-site City inspector.

#### Recycling and Garbage Collection

Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move the items to an appropriate location and return the bins/containers. Please label your bins/containers with your address.

#### Parking

No on-street parking will be available in the work zones until the reconstruction work is completed; however, limited parking will be made available at certain locations, providing it does not interfere with construction.

#### Getting Around on the TTC during Construction

- 512 St. Clair buses are operating on St. Clair Avenue between Gunns Loop at Keele Street and St. Clair West Station at Bathurst Street.
- 512 St. Clair streetcars are operating between St. Clair West Station and St. Clair Station at Yonge Street.



- 312 St. Clair Night buses are operating along regular routing from Jane Station at Bloor Street to the St. Clair Station at Yonge Street.
