Caledonia/St. Clair Intersection Surface Asphalt Paving

On Saturday, September 5th between 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. the surface asphalt paving will require a partial road closure at the intersection of St. Clair/Caledonia.

Details

- Surface asphalt paving of the intersection.
- Safety measures such as barrier fences will be in place surrounding the construction zone.
- A police officer will be on-site during the work to assist with traffic and pedestrian movement.
- Delivery of materials associated with this work will be on-going.
- Pedestrian sidewalk traffic and pedestrian access to businesses will be maintained during the construction.

Traffic Restrictions - St. Clair Avenue

One eastbound and westbound traffic lane will be maintained on St. Clair Avenue West through the Caledonia intersection.

Traffic Restrictions – Caledonia Road

Caledonia Road north of St. Clair Ave West will remain open. However, traffic will not be permitted through the intersection.

Caledonia Road south of St. Clair Ave West will remain open. However, traffic will not be permitted through the intersection.

Deliveries

During construction, deliveries to the front of businesses within the work zone may need to be coordinated with the on-site City inspector.

Recycling and Garbage Collection

Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move the items to an appropriate location and return the bins/containers. Please label your bins/containers with your address.

Parking

No on-street parking will be available in the work zones until track reconstruction is completed; however, limited parking will be made available at certain locations, providing it does not interfere with construction.

Getting Around on the TTC during Construction

- 512 St. Clair buses are operating on St. Clair Avenue between Gunns Loop at Keele Street and St. Clair West Station at Bathurst Street.
- 512 St. Clair streetcars are operating between St. Clair West Station and St. Clair Station at Yonge Street.
- 312 St. Clair Night buses are operating along regular routing from Jane Station at Bloor Street to the St. Clair Station at Yonge Street.



47 LANSDOWNE Bus Route: On Saturday, September 5, 2009.

- Buses will be diverted both ways via: Caledonia Road, Rogers Road, Old Weston Road, St. Clair Avenue and Lansdowne Avenue.
