

St. Clair Avenue West Transit Improvements Project

Silverthorn Avenue and St. Clair Avenue West Intersection Closure for Roadway Reconstruction

Start: Tuesday, September 8, 2009 - 7 a.m.*
End: Tuesday, September 15, 2009 - 6 p.m.*

Silverthorn Ave. and St. Clair Ave. W Intersection Roadway Reconstruction:

Beginning at 7:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 8 to 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 15, 2009 the reconstruction of roadway and TTC track allowance will require a full road closure of Silverthorn Avenue, and Hounslow Heath Road at the St. Clair Ave. West intersection.

Details

- Complete excavation of the roadway area and TTC track allowance; pouring of concrete for a new road base and TTC track allowance;
- Safety measures such as barrier fences will be in place surrounding the construction zone. Pedestrians will be required to walk around the fences.
- Delivery of materials associated with this work will be on-going.
- Pedestrian sidewalk traffic and pedestrian access to businesses will be maintained during the construction.

Traffic Restrictions - St. Clair Avenue

One lane of vehicular traffic, in each direction, on St. Clair Avenue West will be maintained at all time during this construction. 512 St. Clair buses will continue to operate through the intersection.

Traffic Restrictions – Silverthorn Avenue

The through traffic will be completely closed at St. Clair Avenue West; however right turn movement will be allowed from Silverthorn Ave., and from Hounslow Heath Road.

Work Hours

Roadway reconstruction will only be completed during regular work hours. During the construction, noise should be expected. However, the loudest work, such as saw-cutting and the breaking of concrete will be restricted to the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Deliveries

During construction, deliveries to the front of businesses within the work zone may need to be coordinated with the on-site City inspector.

Recycling and Garbage Collection

Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move the items to an appropriate location and return the bins/containers. Please label your bins/containers with your address.

Parking

No on-street parking will be available in the work zones until the reconstruction work is completed; however, limited parking will be made available at certain locations, providing it does not interfere with construction.
