Keele Street and St. Clair Avenue West Intersection

Keele Street Closure for Roadway Reconstruction

Start: Friday, October 2 - 6:00 a.m.*
End: Monday, October 5 - 9:00 a.m.* - Opens to public transit at 7 a.m.

Keele Street and St. Clair Avenue West Intersection

Beginning at 6:00 a.m. on **Friday, October 2nd** to **Monday, October 5th** at 9:00 a.m., reconstruction of eastbound and westbound curb lanes at the Keele Street and St. Clair Avenue West intersection will require a road closure to Keele Street traffic. Keele traffic will **not** be able to access or cross the St. Clair intersection southbound or northbound.

Details

- Safety measures such as barrier fences will be in place surrounding the construction zone. Pedestrians will be required to walk around the fences.
- Pedestrian sidewalk traffic and pedestrian access to businesses will be maintained during the construction.

Traffic Restrictions

- **St. Clair Avenue West:** A minimum of one lane of traffic along St. Clair Avenue will remain open in both directions, allowing vehicles to travel through the intersection. No turns will be permitted.
- **Northbound Keele Street:** Closed. No access to St. Clair Avenue
- **Southbound Keele Street:** Closed. No access to St. Clair Avenue

Signage advising motorists of the closure will be posted in the area.

Work Hours

Roadway reconstruction will generally be completed during regular work hours. However, should work need to extend to later in the evening, the loudest work, such as saw-cutting and the breaking of asphalt and concrete will be restricted to the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. During the construction, noise should be expected.

Deliveries

During construction, deliveries to the front of businesses within the work zone may need to be coordinated with the on-site City inspector.

Parking

No on-street parking will be available in the work zones until the reconstruction work is completed; however, limited parking will be made available at certain locations, providing it does not interfere with construction.

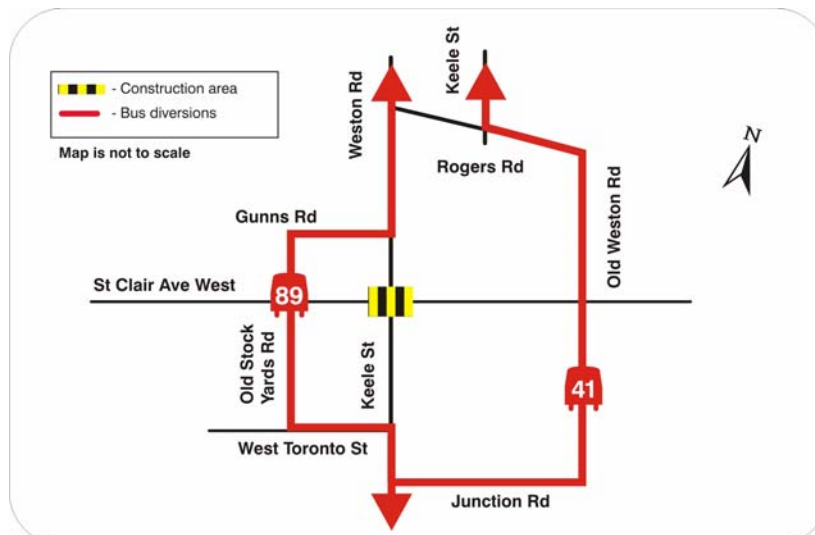
Transit Service Changes:

During this partial closure of the intersection, the 41 Keele and 89 Weston Bus Routes will be affected.

- **41 Keele:** Buses will be diverted both ways via: Keele Street, Rogers Road, Old Weston Road, Junction Road and Keele Street.
- **89 Weston Road:** Buses will be diverted both ways via: Weston Road, Gunns Road, Old Stock Yards Road, West Toronto Street and Keele Street.

Note: 512 St. Clair: Service will continue to operate through the intersection during the work.
