

St. Clair Avenue West Transit Improvements Project

Old Weston Road and St. Clair Avenue West Intersection Partial Closure for Track and Road Reconstruction

Start: Friday, October 16 - 4:00 a.m.*

End: Tuesday, October 20 - 7:00 a.m.*

Old Weston Road and St. Clair Avenue West Intersection

Beginning at 4:00 a.m. on Friday, October 16, to 7:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 20, streetcar track reconstruction and roadwork will require a partial closure to the intersection affecting the northbound and southbound traffic on Old Weston Road at St. Clair Avenue West.

Details

- Track reconstruction in the intersection will begin shortly after the traffic restrictions have been put into place.
- Safety measures such as barrier fences will be in place surrounding the construction zone. Pedestrians will be required to walk around the fences.
- The existing streetcar track will be completely excavated so that new streetcar rails can be installed on a new concrete track base.
- Delivery of materials associated with this work will be on-going.
- A temporary walkway/ramp will be placed at an excavated section of the intersection to maintain pedestrian crossing. Pedestrian sidewalk traffic and pedestrian access to businesses will be maintained during the construction.

Traffic Restrictions

- **St. Clair Avenue West:** A minimum of one lane of traffic along St. Clair Avenue will remain open in both directions, allowing vehicles to travel through the intersection. No left turns will be permitted.
- **Old Weston Rd:** Traffic on Old Weston Road will **not** be able to cross St. Clair Avenue.
- **Right turns** will be maintained at all four corners of the intersection.

TTC Transit Service Changes: (see transit map on reverse)

41 Keele Buses:

Southbound buses will operate over regular routing.

Northbound buses will be diverted via: north on Keele Street, north of Weston Road, east on Rogers Road, and north on Keele Street to route.

127 Davenport Buses: will loop via: west on Davenport Road, north on Old Weston Road, east on St. Clair Avenue, south on Ford Street and east on Davenport Road to route.

168 Symington Buses:

Southbound buses will be diverted via: east on Rogers Road, south on Caledonia Road, south on Caledonia Park Road, west on Davenport Road and south Symington Avenue to route.

Northbound buses will be diverted via: north on Symington Avenue, east on Davenport Road, north on Caledonia Park Road, north on Caledonia Road, west on St. Clair Avenue and north on Old Weston Road to route.

512-312 St. Clair Service: No changes.

Work Hours

Streetcar track reconstruction at major intersections, such as Old Weston Road and St. Clair Avenue, involve periods of 24-hour operation. Heavy construction work may begin earlier than 7:00 a.m. and may also be extended up to 11 p.m. The overnight operation activities involve TTC rail installation work consisting of delivery of rail, rail installation and rail welding/grinding, and possibly the placing of concrete. The night work is required to support the daytime construction and complete the project as quickly as possible. While every effort will be made to minimize construction noise during the work periods, noise should be expected.

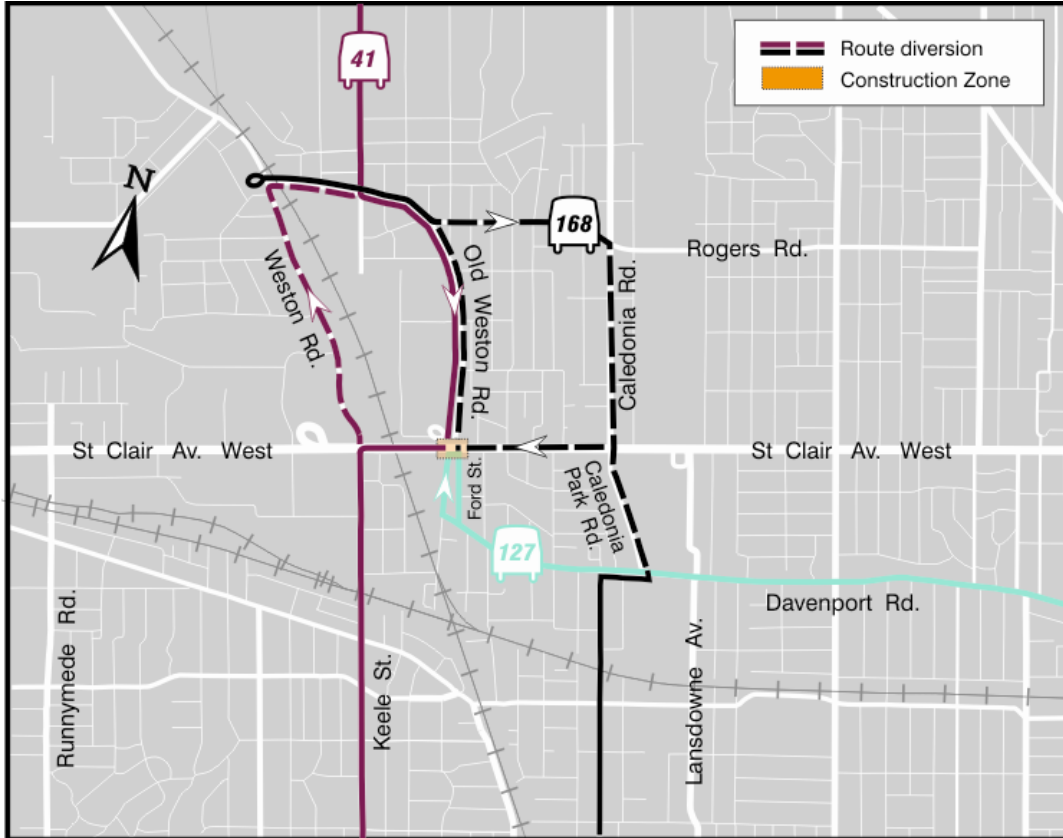
Deliveries, Recycling/Garbage Collection and Parking

During construction, deliveries to the front of businesses within the work zone will need to be made from side streets or be coordinated with the on-site City inspector. Please follow your normal routine waste and recycling collection. On-street parking in the vicinity of the St. Clair/Old Weston Road intersection will be affected during this work.
