

St. Clair Avenue West Transit Improvements Project

Old Weston Road to Gunns Road and Loop TTC Track and Roadway Reconstruction

Start: Monday, March 29, 2010
End: Wednesday, June 30, 2010

* Timeline is subject to change due to unforeseen events. Content is accurate and current at time of printing.

The majority of heavy construction work; new track, streetcar passenger platforms, roadway and sidewalk from McRoberts Avenue to Keele Street/Weston Road is now completed. Overhead streetcar power line and poles remain to be installed.

All work related to this project is scheduled for completion in summer 2010.

Scope of Upcoming Work

Reconstruction of TTC track allowance and the roadway between 150 metres west of Gunns Road and Keele Street. Reconstruction of Gunns loop at the northwest corner of Gunns Road and St. Clair Ave. West intersection. The landscape work and the surface asphalt paving will be completed between Old Weston Road and 150 metres west of Gunns Road.

Details

- Safety measures such as barrier fences will be in place surrounding the construction zone. Pedestrians will be required to walk around the fences.
- Pedestrian sidewalk traffic and pedestrian access to businesses will be maintained during the construction.

Traffic Restrictions

- **St. Clair Avenue West:** A minimum of one lane of traffic along St. Clair Avenue will remain open in both directions.
- **Gunns Road:** Only southbound lane will be maintained between the period from March 29, 2010 and May 1, 2010. The access to the Gunns Road northbound will be closed at St. Clair Avenue West. Signage advising motorists of the closure will be posted in the area.

Work Hours

Roadway reconstruction will generally be completed during regular work hours. However, should work need to extend to later in the evening, the loudest work, such as saw-cutting and the breaking of asphalt and concrete will be restricted to the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. During the construction, noise should be expected.

Deliveries

During construction, deliveries to the front of businesses within the work zone may need to be coordinated with the on-site City inspector, please approach the inspector.

Parking

No on-street parking will be available in the work zones until the reconstruction work is completed; however, limited parking may be made available at certain locations, when it does not interfere with construction.

Transit Service Update:

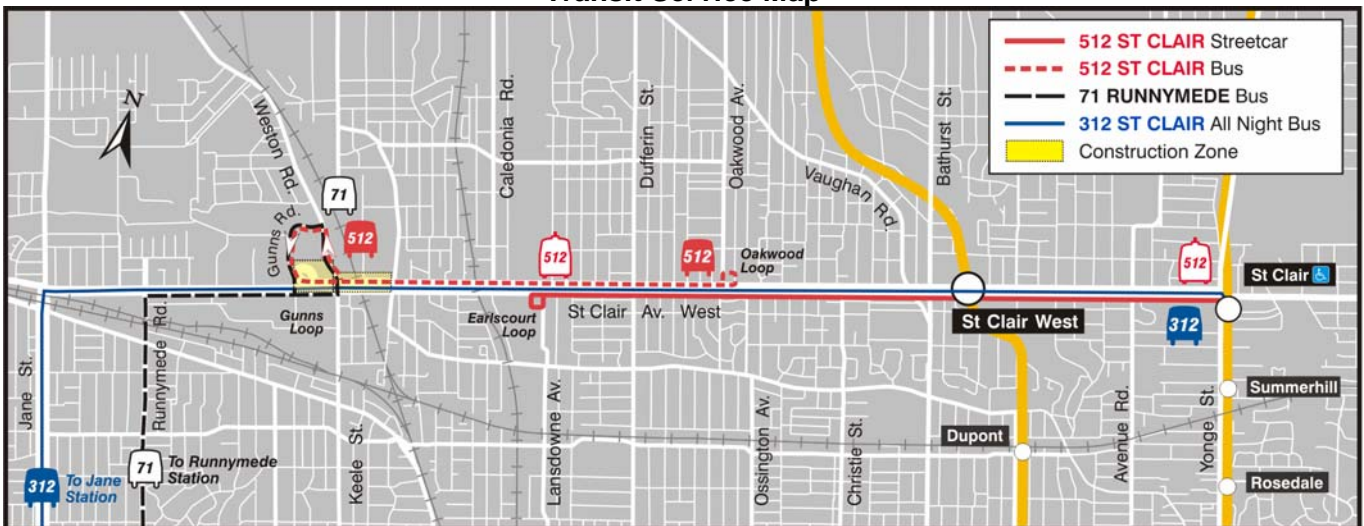
- 512 St Clair buses are operating on St. Clair Avenue between Gunns Loop (see Transit Map on reverse) at Keele Street and Oakwood Loop at Oakwood Avenue until the completion of the St Clair right-of-way when streetcar service along the entire 512 route will resume.
- 512 St Clair streetcars are operating on the new right-of-way from St. Clair Station at Yonge Street to the Earls court loop at Lansdowne Avenue.
- 312 St Clair night buses are operating along regular routing from Jane Station at Bloor Street to the St. Clair Station at Yonge Street (see Transit Map on reverse).

Transit Service Change: Gunns Loop

Gunns Loop will be closed in its entirety due to construction work inside the loop beginning immediately. This closure will affect buses operating on the 512 St. Clair and the 71 Runnymede routes to loop use Gunns Road. On-site signage will be posted to indicate the stop location on Gunn’s Road for passenger pick up/drop off. The 2 routes will now “turn” at the following locations:

- 512 St. Clair buses - from St. Clair Avenue, eastbound buses will turn north onto Weston Road then turn west onto Gunns Road, continue south, and turn east back onto the St Clair Avenue route and head westbound.
- 71 Runnymede buses - from Runnymede Road, buses heading westbound on St. Clair Avenue, will turn north onto Keele Street\Weston Road, turn west onto Gunns Road, continue south, and turn west back onto the St. Clair Ave. route.
