

Study Commencement Notice

St. Clair Ave. West Transit Improvements

Environmental Assessment

The Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) and City of Toronto have initiated a study to identify and evaluate options for improved streetcar operations on St. Clair Ave. West between Gunns Road (just west of Keele Street) to just east of Yonge Street. The St. Clair Ave. West streetcar tracks are in poor condition and urgently require replacement (scheduled for 2005). The work provides the opportunity to review possible enhancements to the streetcar and road infrastructure as part of the broader overall improvements planned for St. Clair Ave. West.

This study is being undertaken in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) process, Schedule C projects. There will be several public meetings held in the community throughout the process. The first public meeting will be held in the fall of 2003.
