| CATEGORY                      | DESCRIPTION  | RELATIVE VALUE WEIGHT (% OF 100%) |
|-------------------------------|--|-----------------------------------|
| <b>Transit Service</b>        | Shows the ability of the alternatives to improve reliability, efficiency and safety of transit service, in order to serve existing and future needs.   |                                   |
| <b>Transportation Service</b> | Shows the ability of the alternatives to satisfy transportation needs, operations and safety for other road users, including pedestrians, automobiles, cyclists and delivery vehicles.             |                                   |
| <b>Community and Business</b> | Shows the ability of the alternatives to meet community planning and Official Plan objectives, effects on business operations and economy, and effects on neighbourhoods and community facilities. |                                   |
| <b>Natural Environment</b>    | Shows the potential effects of the alternatives on the natural environment including air quality and any sensitive natural habitats.   |                                   |
| <b>Costs</b>                  | Shows the financial implication of the alternatives including construction, capital, operating and maintenance costs.  |                                   |
| <b>TOTAL</b>                  |  | <b>100 %</b>                      |
