

# OPEN HOUSE

**T**he City of Toronto invites you to an Open House to view and comment on plans for construction of stormwater treatment facilities in the Ellis Avenue and Colborne Lodge area.

An environmental study completed in 2002, identified a preferred alternative for control and use of stormwater from the areas drained by Ellis Avenue and Colborne Lodge Drive storm sewers. The objective is to minimize negative environmental effects and enhance the beneficial use of stormwater in both natural and built environments.

The treatment facilities will include the creation of wetlands/forebays in the following areas: the West (Catfish) Pond, the southwest part of Grenadier Pond, the area south of Lakeshore Boulevard near the Humber River, and in the area between Lakeshore Boulevard and the Gardiner Expressway west and east of Colborne Lodge Drive. Oil and grit separators are also being constructed in specified areas.
