The OEM works in partnership with the City's Emergency Response partners to coordinate response plans and procedures in an emergency situation. Our response partners include:

- Toronto Emergency Medical Services (EMS)
- Toronto Fire Services
- Toronto Police Service
- Toronto Public Health Emergency Services Unit
- Toronto Community & Neighbourhood Services

The OEM also serves to educate residents so they can prepare themselves for any event that might occur.

What should you do?

As a resident you are responsible for your own preparedness. Take steps to protect yourself and your family:

- Prepare emergency survival kits for your home, vehicles and to take with you in case you need to leave.
- Prepare a list of important contact numbers.
