

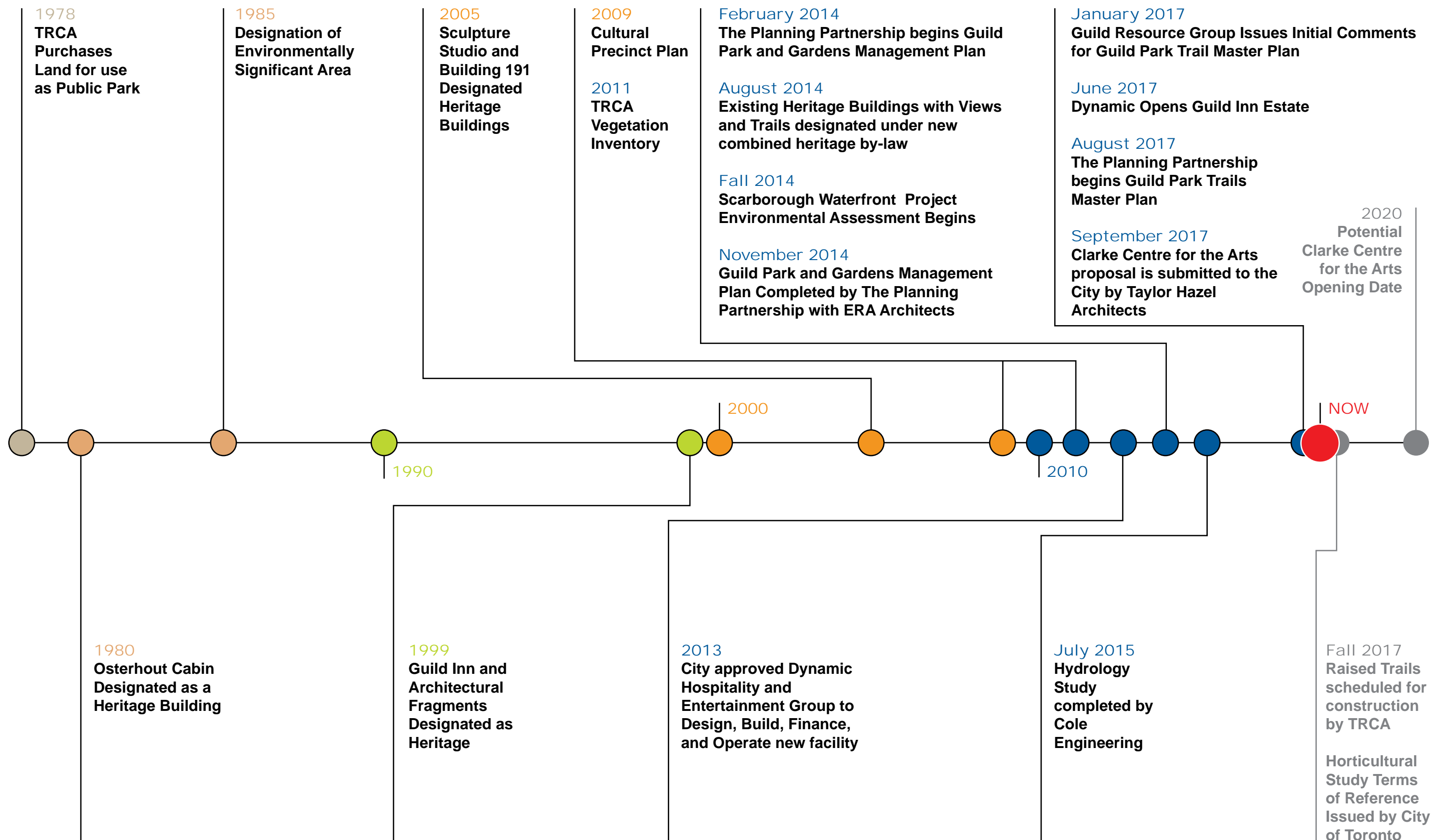

KEY ACTIONS

- 2014 The Planning Partnership begins Guild Park and Gardens Management Plan
- 2014 Scarborough Waterfront Project Environmental Assessment begins
- 2017 Clarke Centre for the Arts proposal is submitted to the City by Taylor Hazel Architects
- 2017 Raised trails scheduled for construction by TRCA

The Guild Park & Gardens Trails Master Plan builds on the framework established in the Management Plan completed in 2014.

RESULTS OF RECENT USER SURVEY

KEY FINDINGS

- 1 Travel distances are evenly distributed, from less than 1km to more than 20km.
- 2 The most common visitor frequencies are **several times a year** and **several times a week**.
- 3 The most frequently cited attraction are the **monuments and gardens**.
- 4 The most used trails are the **Monument and Gardens Walk** and the **Waterfront Trail**

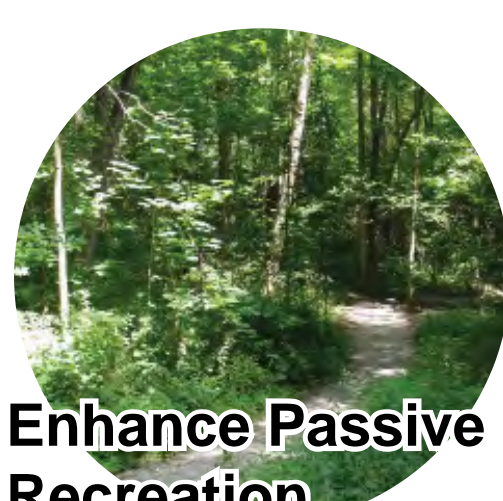

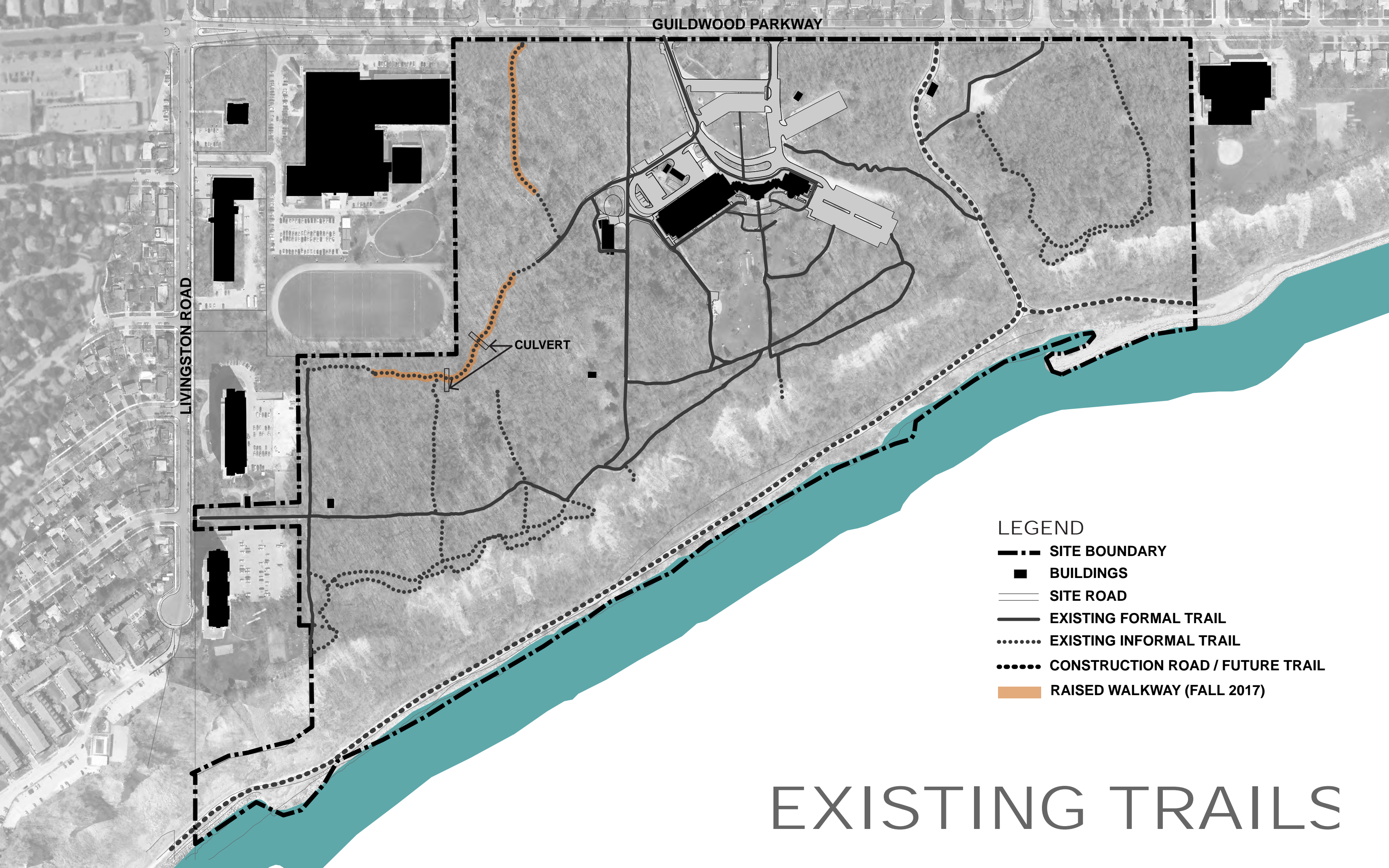

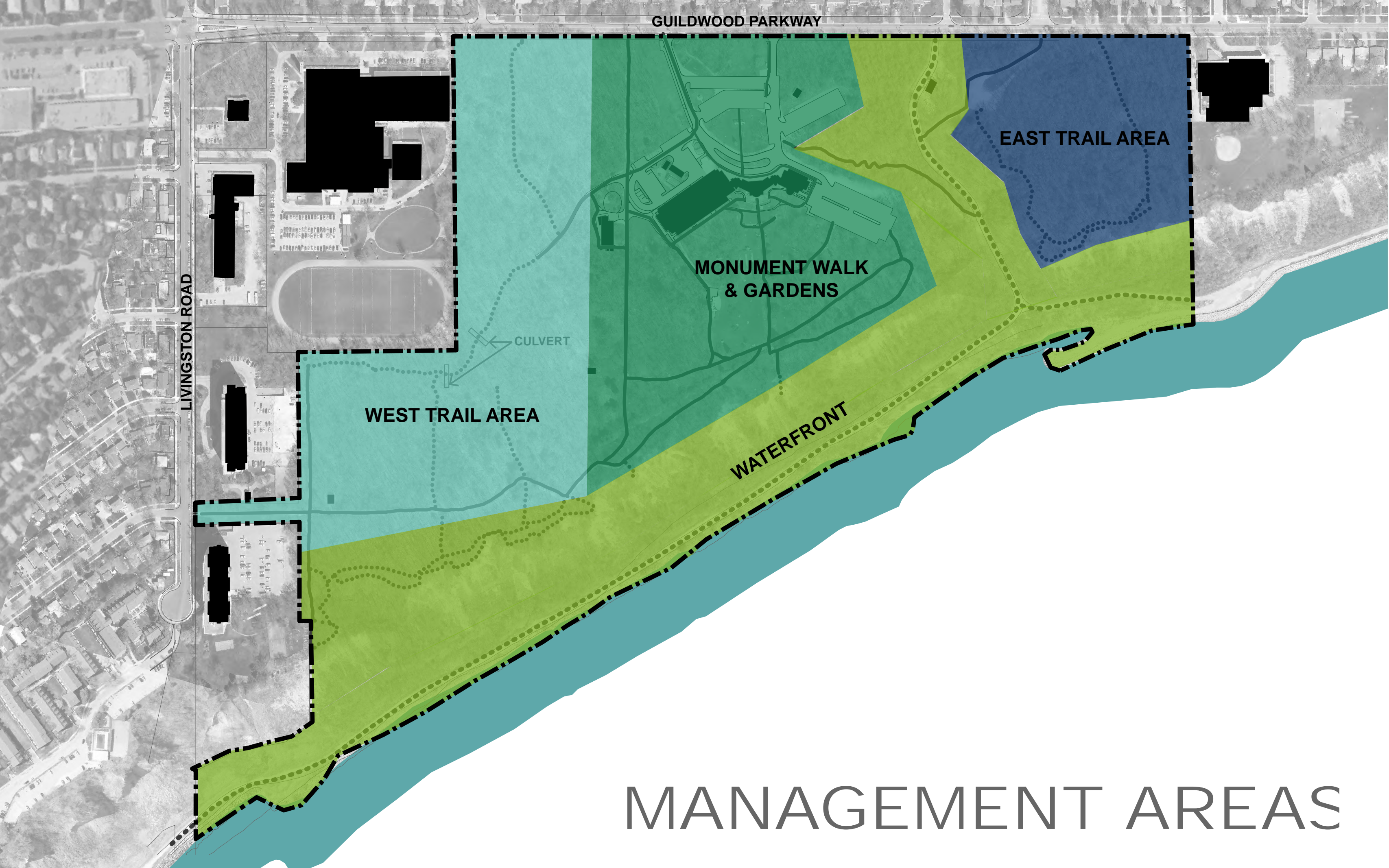
