Ruling on Standing

BACKGROUND

Today, I released a decision regarding who would be granted Standing at the Toronto External Contracts Inquiry. That ruling made reference to certain parties with standing at the Toronto External Contracts Inquiry also making application to have standing at the Toronto Computer Leasing Inquiry. For ease of reference in the Toronto Computer Leasing Inquiry, I duplicate what I said in the ruling at the Standing Hearings into the Toronto External Contracts Inquiry:

To the extent that evidence received at this Inquiry may engage their substantial and direct interest, I have decided to grant them full standing in the Toronto Computer Leasing Inquiry.”
