## DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPAL CONFLICT OF INTEREST ACT.

## 1. RECOMMENDED GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE FOR WATER AND WASTEWATER SERVICES.

DEPUTATIONS: 2:00 p.m., June 11, 2002

Chief Administrative Officer (May 31, 2002)

Recommending that:

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- (1) Council endorse the municipal service board model for water and wastewater services as described in this report, with the following key characteristics:
  - the City is the employer;
  - Council appoints the board;
  - the board comprises a mix of Councillors and expert citizens;
  - Council approves annual operating budgets and multi-year capital programs; and
  - Council approves the water rate;

- (2) the Chief Administrative Officer report back to Policy and Finance Committee in November 2002 with a detailed implementation plan, including an effective implementation date, using the process outlined in this report;
- (3) the Chief Administrative Officer continue to monitor developments in provincial legislation respecting the City's authority to create a municipally-owned not-for-profit corporation for water and wastewater services, and report back on any opportunities arising out of those developments that Council may wish to consider;
- (4) the current review of inter- and intra-departmental charges be undertaken with a view to ensuring the services provided meet the business needs of Water and Wastewater Services;
- (5) service-level agreements be initiated for charge-backs to Water and Wastewater Services;
- (6) the current review of inter- and intra-departmental charges include the development of a policy on payment for water and wastewater services by City Departments, Agencies, Boards and Commissions; and
- (7) the appropriate City officials be authorized and directed to take the necessary action to give effect thereto.
