**1. The City of Toronto Corporate Smog Alert Response Plan: Status Report**

Report (June 23, 2003) from the Medical Officer of Health reporting on the implementation of the City of Toronto Corporate Smog Alert Response Plan and the impact of smog alert days on the delivery of City services; and recommending that:

- (1) the Commissioner of Works and Emergency Services, as Chair of the Toronto Interdepartmental Environment Committee (TIE), ensure that the City's Corporate Air Quality Strategy includes consideration of year-long corporate actions by City Divisions, Agencies, Boards and Commissions that reduce smog; and
- (2) the appropriate City officials be authorized and directed to take the necessary action to give effect thereto.

**2. City Auditor 2002 Follow-up: Review of Food Safety Program, Toronto Public Health**

Report (June 30, 2003) from the Medical Officer of Health providing a detailed response on the nature and extent of action taken by the Medical Officer of Health in response to the City Auditor's November 2002 Follow-up report on the Food Safety Program and recommending that that this report be received for information.

**3. Mobile Dental Program for Low-Income Seniors Living in Long-Term Care Facilities**

Report (July 2, 2003) from the Medical Officer of Health providing the Board of Health with information on the cost to fully harmonize mobile dental services for low income residents of long-term care facilities (LTC) at the current level of service in existence in the South Region, the health benefits of such a service, and eligibility criteria to ensure that the program targets only those seniors who are unable to afford such services elsewhere; and recommending that that this report be received for information.
