Background:

Section No. 247 of The Municipal Act (R.S.O. 1990), provides that the Treasurer of every municipality shall submit to the Council of the municipality, in each year, a statement of the remuneration and expenses paid in the preceding year to each Member of Council in respect of his/her services as a Member of Council or as an officer of the municipal corporation and also to each Member of Council or other person appointed by Council to a local board or other special purpose body.

This report is in respect of the remuneration earned and expenses paid to Members of Council and Council Appointees to Local Boards and Other Special Purpose Bodies for the year 2002, and is outlined in two sections. (a) Members of Council:

The table below summarizes the remuneration and expenses of Members of Council for the year ended December 31, 2002, based on remuneration earned and expenses paid during the year. It includes remuneration and expenses paid by Local Boards and Other Special Purpose Bodies and other City Departments. Appendix A provides details of remuneration and benefits for each Councillor. Appendix B shows a breakdown, by expense component, of each Councillor's office expenses. Appendix C provides details of conference and other travel costs, from all funding sources, for each Councillor. Appendix D shows expenses charged to City Departments and Appendix E shows remuneration and expenses paid by Local Boards and Other Special Purpose Bodies. Appendix F shows expenses of the Mayor's office. The authority for these payments is listed on Appendix G.
