
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: March 8, 2012
Summary of Decisions
Agrawal / Borer / Hall

1. Estate of Wassan Singh (*Report No. 5822*)

Savinder Singh - Executor

Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-4187432 for Taxicab Plate No. 2597.

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Taxicab owner's licence No. V02-4187432, plate No. 2597 in the Estate of Wassan Singh is extended for a period of one year with the following condition:

- The Estate must make best efforts to transfer the licence within the one year extension period.

2. Amir Malik (*Report No. 5769*)

Applicant for Renewal of Driving Instructor's Licence No. V11-4074416.

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to April 26, 2012 *peremptory* to Mr. Malik.
(Mr. Malik did not attend today's hearing.)

3. David Quigley (*Report no. 5744*)

Applicant for Renewal of Tow Truck Driver's Licence No. D09-3834117.

The Tribunal renewed David Quigley's tow truck driver's licence No. D09-3834117, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued the licence will be suspended for a period of three (3) days;
- (2) immediately upon being re-instated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Quigley must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Quigley incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or the Toronto Municipal Code, he

must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days; and

- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5744 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

4. Neil Monck (*Report No. 5757*)

Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. B187066).

The Tribunal granted Neil Monck's application (No. B187066) for a tow truck driver's licence, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of four (4) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next four renewals of the licence, Mr. Monck must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record and criminal record check;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Monck incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, the *Highway Traffic Act* or the Toronto Municipal Code, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5757 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

5. Nasir Ahmed (*Report No. 5758*)

Applicant for a Limousine Driver's Licence (Application No. B187031).

The Tribunal denied Nasir Ahmed's application (No. B187031) for a limousine driver's licence.

6. Nicolina Todeva (*Report No. 5768*)

Applicant for a Refreshment Vehicle Assistant's Licence (Application No. B186879).

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Nicolina Todeva's application (No. B186879) for a refreshment vehicle assistant's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Ms. Todeva must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at her own expense, an updated criminal record check;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Ms. Todeva incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, she must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5768 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

7. **Yohanes Melaku** (*Report No. 5730*)
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's (Lapsed) Licence (Application No. B074020).

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to May 10, 2012 for the matter to be heard by a new panel.

The Tribunal ordered the attendance of a new Amharic interpreter for the hearing on May 10, 2012.
