## BY-LAW -2023

## To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 510, Holiday Shopping.

Whereas the City of Toronto Act, 2006 authorizes Council to require business establishments to be closed to the public at any time, but exempts the sale or offering for sale by retail of goods or services in the form of or in connection with prepared meals; and

Whereas Council has therefore approved an amendment to Chapter 510, Holiday Shopping, pursuant to this authority;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. Section § 510-5 of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 510, Holiday Shopping, is amended as follows:
  - a. by adding the words "or locations" immediately after the words "pursuant to the following by-laws" so that it reads:

This chapter is not applicable to retail business establishments authorized to remain open on holidays pursuant to the following by-laws or locations: and

- b. by adding the following as new subsections § 510-5F, G and H:
  - F. By-law No. 328-2011 (St. Lawrence Market Neighbourhood Business Improvement Area).
  - G. Yorkdale Shopping Centre; and
  - H. Scarborough Town Centre
