Bill 266

BY-LAW -2024

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Ellesmere Road, Military Trail and Orton Park Road.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XXIII (Prohibited Turns) in § 950-1322, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(From Column 2 Direction)	(From Column 3 Turns Prohibited)	(From Column 4 Times and/or Days)
Ellesmere Road and Military Trail (west intersection)/Orton Park Road	Eastbound	Left	7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays

B. By inserting in Schedule XXIII (Prohibited Turns) in § 950-1322, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(In Column 2 Direction)	(In Column 3 Turns Prohibited)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)
Ellesmere Road and Military Trail (west intersection)/Orton Park Road	Eastbound	Left	7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays (bicycles excepted)
Ellesmere Road and Military Trail (west intersection)/Orton Park Road	Westbound	Right	7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays (bicycles excepted)

C. By deleting from Schedule XXIV (Compulsory Turns) in § 950-1323, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway Being Entered)	(From Column 2 Highway from which Vehicle Enters)	(From Column 3 Highway Not To Be Entered)
Ellesmere Road	Orton Park Road	Military Trail, from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays

D. By inserting in Schedule XXIV (Compulsory Turns) in § 950-1323, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway Being Entered)	(In Column 2 Highway from which Vehicle Enters)	(In Column 3 Highway Not To Be Entered)
Ellesmere Road	Orton Park Road	Military Trail, from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays (bicycles excepted)
