BY-LAW -2024

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 608, Parks, to add parks to the Schedule A list of parks at which the personal possession and consumption of liquor is allowed.

Whereas under sections 7 and 8 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006, the City may pass by-laws respecting the use of its parks system; and

Whereas subsection 41(1) of the Liquor Licence and Control Act allows council of a municipality to designate by by-law a public area for persons to consume liquor; and

Whereas Council amended Municipal Code Chapter 608, Parks, to establish a process for allowing the possession and consumption of liquor in parks, and to include additional parks in Schedule A; and

Whereas Council authorized the City Solicitor to submit bills for enactment by Council to add parks to the Municipal Code Chapter 608, Parks Schedule A list of parks at which the personal consumption of liquor is allowed, in accordance with the process set out in § 608-8C and D;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Chapter 608, Parks, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by deleting Schedule "A", Parks at Which a Person may Possess an Open Container of Liquor and Consume Liquor under § 608-8D and replacing it with Schedule A attached to this bylaw.
