**Bill 1367**

**BY-LAW -2024**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, to provide  
for Ontario Line Vehicles.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting a new definition of ONTARIO LINE VEHICLE in alphabetical order in § 950-101B.3 as follows:

ONTARIO LINE VEHICLE - A vehicle clearly identified by markings as 'Ontario Line' that is actively engaged transporting materials and equipment related to work on the Ontario Line.

B. By inserting in Schedule XXIII (Prohibited Turns) in § 950-1322, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(In Column 2 Direction)	(In Column 3 Turns Prohibited)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)
King Street West and Portland Street	Eastbound and Westbound	Through	Anytime (Ontario Line Vehicles excepted from December 23, 2024 to December 31, 2027, inclusive)
