**Bill 227**

**BY-LAW -2026**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting Harbour Street and Lake Shore Boulevard West.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes, and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule E (Cycle Tracks) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Harbour Street	Lower Simcoe Street and a point 130 metres east	Southerly Eastbound	Anytime
Harbour Street	Lower Simcoe Street and a point 130 metres east	Southerly Westbound lane adjacent to the southerly eastbound cycle track	Anytime
Lake Shore Boulevard West	Lower Simcoe Street and a point 15 metres west	Southerly Eastbound	Anytime
Lake Shore Boulevard West	Lower Simcoe Street and a point 15 metres west	Southerly Westbound lane adjacent to the southerly eastbound cycle track	Anytime
