BY-LAW No. 572-2000

**A By-law to Amend Chapter 255 of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code –
Clothing Optional Beach at Hanlon’s Point.**

WHEREAS by the adoption, as amended, of Clause No. 2 of Report No. 2 of the Economic Development and Parks Committee on February 29, March 1 and 2, 2000 Council approved a pilot project for a clothing optional beach at Hanlon’s Point on the Toronto Islands for two operating seasons in 2000 and 2001; and

WHEREAS Chapter 255 – Parks of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code provides that no person shall utilize facilities in any park without being properly attired, including appropriate swimwear or beach clothing; and

WHEREAS an amendment is required in order to provide for the designated clothing optional area at Hanlan’s Point Beach.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 255-17 of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding a new subsection 255-17E to read as follows:

E. Notwithstanding subsection D, clothing shall be optional in the designated clothing optional beach area at Hanlan’s Point Beach.
