SCHEDULE “A”

1. Section 18 of the Official Plan for the former City of Toronto, is hereby amended by adding the following Section 18.522 and the attached Map 18.522;

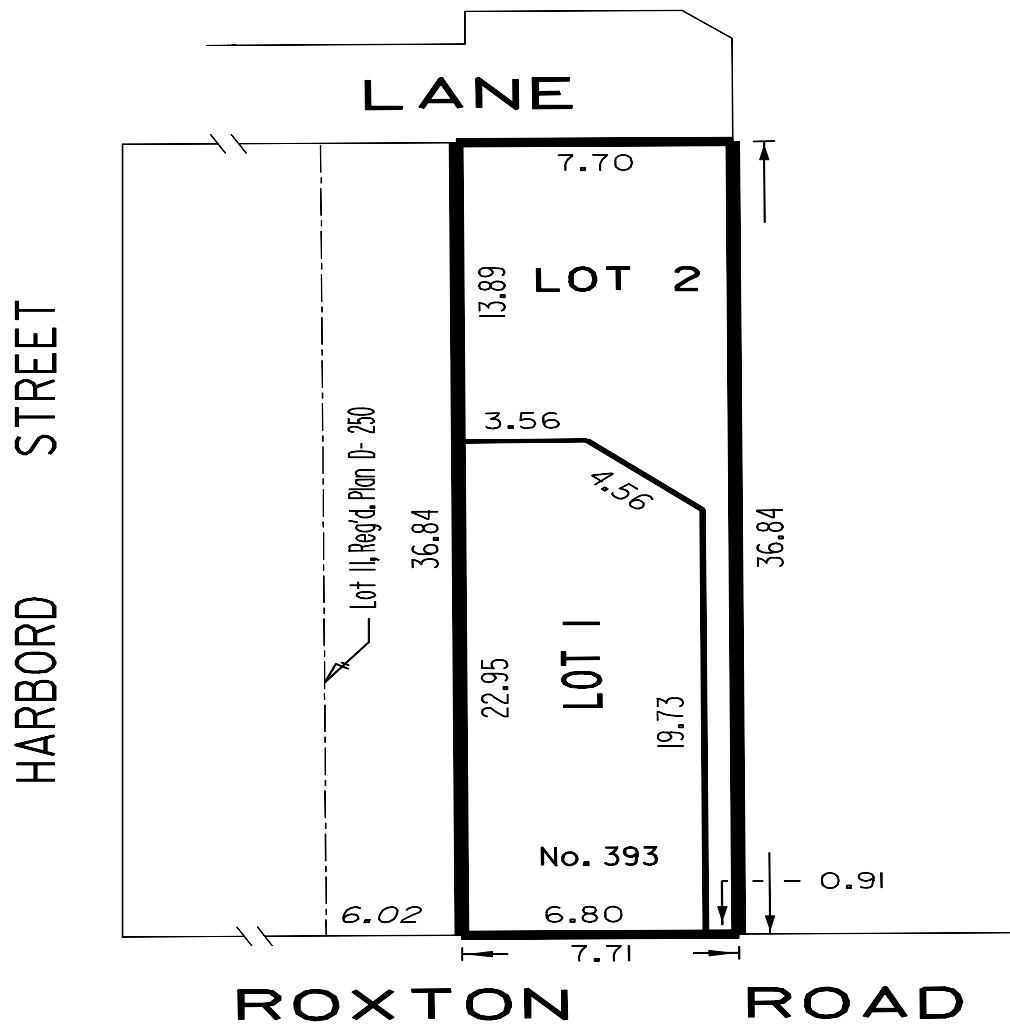
“18.522 Lands known as No. 393 Roxton Road

Notwithstanding any of the provisions of this Plan, Council may pass by-laws applicable to the lands delineated by heavy lines on Map 18.522, to permit the erection or use of a *residential* building on each *lot* and up to the *residential gross floor area* as hereinafter set out:

Lot No.	Maximum <u><i>residential gross floor area</i></u> (<i>square metres</i>)
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1	190
2	120”.
