BY-LAW No. 443-2002

To amend By-law No. 226-1998 to appoint James K. Laughlin as Deputy Chief Building Official for the South District and to repeal the appointment of Pamela Coburn as Deputy Chief Building Official.

WHEREAS subsection 3(2) of the *Building Code Act*, 1992, requires the council of each municipality to appoint a chief building official; and

WHEREAS under section 28(o) of the *Interpretation Act*, words directing the appointment of a public officer to administer an Act also include the power of appointing a deputy to have all the powers and authority of the public officer or such limited powers as the instrument appointing him or her prescribes; and

WHEREAS Council has determined that James K. Laughlin will succeed Pamela Coburn as Deputy Chief Building Official for the South District;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 3(1) of By-law No. 226-1998, as amended by By-law No. 10-1999, is further amended by deleting the words "Pamela Coburn" and substituting "James K. Laughlin".
2. Subsection 3(2) of By-law No. 226-1998, as amended by By-law No. 10-1999, is further amended by deleting the words "Pamela Coburn" from Column 1 and substituting "James K. Laughlin".
