## CITY OF TORONTO

## BY-LAW No. 572-2002

To authorize the establishment of designated bicycle lanes on both sides of Browns Line between Lake Shore Boulevard West and points further north.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the establishment of designated bicycle lanes was published in a daily newspaper on May 14, 20, 27 and June 3, 2002 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on June 5, 2002 and it is appropriate to permit that designation;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** The following bicycle lanes are designated:

Browns Line, west side, from a point 227 metres north of Lake Shore Boulevard West to Lake Shore Boulevard West

Browns Line, east side, from Lakeshore Boulevard West to a point 277 metres further north.
