CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 614-2002

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking,
respecting Dufferin Street, Lansdowne Avenue, Marion Street and Ritchie Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

- A. By deleting from Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (From Column 1) | (From Column 2) | (From Column 3) | (From Column 4) |
|--------------------|--------------------|--|--------------------|
| Dufferin Street | West | A point 20 metres south of Bank Street and a point 5.5 metres further south | Anytime |

- B. By inserting in Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (In Column 1) | (In Column 2) | (In Column 3) | (In Column 4) |
|---------------------|------------------|--|------------------|
| Lansdowne Avenue | East | A point 63.5 metres south of Bloor Street West and a point 5.5 metres further south | Anytime |
| Marion Street | South | A point 9.0 metres east of Roncesvalles Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east | Anytime |
| Ritchie Avenue | South | A point 26.0 metres east of Roncesvalles Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east | Anytime |
