**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 673-2002**

**To stop up and close portions of Scrivener Square, extending easterly from Yonge Street, north of Price Street, to a depth of not more than 0.5 metres below finished grade, and to authorize the sale thereof.**

WHEREAS it is recommended that portions of Scrivener Square, extending easterly from Yonge Street, north of Price Street, to a depth of not more than 0.5 metres below finished grade, be stopped up and closed as a public highway and be sold to the abutting owner upon the terms and conditions set out in Clause No. 31 of Toronto East York Community Council Report No. 9, as adopted by Council at its meeting held on December 4, 5 and 6, 2001; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to stop up and close the said portions of highway and to authorize the sale thereof was published in a daily newspaper on August 23, 30, September 6 and 13, 2002 and no one who claimed that the person's land would be prejudicially affected by the said by-law applied to be heard;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portions of Scrivener Square, extending easterly from Yonge Street, north of Price Street, described as follows:

Part of PIN 21119-0070 (LT)

Pcl Street-1, Sec 66M2315.

Part of the Public Highway Scrivener Square on Plan 66M-2315 designated as Parts 1, 3, 5, 6 and 10 on Plan 66R-19533 in the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario are hereby stopped up and closed as a public highway.

2. The soil and freehold of the portion of public highway stopped up and closed by Section 1 of this By-law shall be sold to the abutting owner upon the terms and conditions set out in Clause No. 31 of Toronto East York Community Council Report No. 9, as adopted by Council at its meeting held on December 4, 5 and 6, 2001.
