## BY-LAW No. 978-2002

2. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Weston Road West Coronado Court and Verobeach Anytime (M.T. 17) Boulevard

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

3. Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:
