CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 978-2002

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1.** Schedule VI (Prohibited Pedestrian Crossings) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)
Keele Street (M.T. 13)	Between the north curb line of St. Regis Crescent and a point 30.5 metres south of the south curb line of St. Regis Crescent
Steeles Avenue West and New Westminster Drive/Black Hawkway (M.T. 34)	Between the east curb line of New Westminster Drive/Black Hawkway and a point 30.5 metres west of the west curb line of New Westminster Drive/Black Hawkway

- 2.** Schedule VIII (No Parking) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Weston Road (M.T. 17)	West	Coronado Court and Verobeach Boulevard	Anytime
--------------------------	------	--	---------

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Weston Road (M.T. 17)	Both	Sheppard Avenue West and Finch Avenue West	Anytime

3. Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Keele Street and St. Regis Crescent (M.T. 13)	Westbound	Right	When traffic control signal shows red
Steeles Avenue West and New Westminster Drive/Black Hawkway (M.T. 34)	Southbound	Right	When traffic control signal shows red
