## CITY OF TORONTO

## BY-LAW No. 1023-2002

To amend Article I, Building Permits, of Municipal Code Chapter 363, Building Construction and Demolition, to cap the initial payment of permit fees.

WHEREAS Council has the authority to pass this by-law under section 7 of the *Building Code Act*, 1992;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Article I, Building Permits, of Chapter 363, Building Construction and Demolition, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:
  - A. Subsection 363-4B(5) is deleted and the following substituted:
    - "(5) Be accompanied by a deposit equal to the Chief Building Official's preliminary estimate of the fees required by this Article. For fees estimated at more than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000), the deposit shall be the greater of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) or an amount equal to sixty (60) percent of the preliminary estimate of the fees";
  - B. Subsection 363-6B is deleted and the following substituted:
    - "B. Refusal of permit.
      - (1) No permit shall be issued until the full fees therefor have been paid.
      - (2) Despite subsection (1), where the permit fees exceed twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000), permits for excavation and shoring may be issued before the full fees have been paid if the deposit required under § 363-4B(5) has been paid".
