BY-LAW No. 9-2003

To amend By-law No. 2958-94 of the former City of York, being a By-law “To regulate traffic on City of York Roads”.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

NO PARKING - SCHEDULE VIII

1. That Schedule VIII of former City of York By-law No. 2958-94, as amended, be further amended by deleting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of said Schedule the following:

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Highway</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Side</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Between</u>	<u>Column 4</u> <u>Prohibited</u> <u>Times or Days</u>
Brookside Avenue	West	St. Mark's Road and a point 60 metres north thereof	8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday
Watson Avenue	East	St. Mark's Road and a point 55 metres north thereof	8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday

ONE-WAY STREETS - SCHEDULE XII

2. That Schedule XII of former City of York By-law No. 2958-94, as amended be further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of said Schedule the following:

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Highway</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Between</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Prohibited</u> <u>Times or Days</u>	<u>Column 4</u> <u>Direction</u>
Brookside Avenue	St. Mark's Road and St. John's Road	Anytime	Southbound
Watson Avenue	St. Mark's Road and St. John's Road	Anytime	Northbound
