BY-LAW No. 15-2003

To permanently close part of the public highway Viking Road.

WHEREAS it is recommended that part of the public highway Viking Road be permanently closed as a public highway and be sold on the terms and conditions set out in Clause No. 240 of Administration Committee Report No. 16, as adopted by the former City of Etobicoke Council at its meeting held on September 22, 1997; Clause No. 11 of Etobicoke Community Council Report No. 14, as adopted by City of Toronto Council at its meeting held on December 14, 15 and 16, 1999; Notice of Motion J(7), moved by Councillor Milczyn, seconded by Councillor Holyday, as adopted by City of Toronto Council at its meeting held on June 26, 27 and 28, 2001, and Notice of Motion J(23), moved by Councillor Milczyn, seconded by Councillor Holyday, as adopted by City of Toronto Council at its regular meeting held on November 26, 27 and 28, 2002; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said portion of highway was published in a daily newspaper on January 6, 2003, and was posted on the notices page of the City's web site for at least the two week period immediately preceding the Etobicoke Community Council meeting held on January 21, 2003 and no one appeared to address the Etobicoke Community Council;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of the public highway Viking Road, described as follows:

Part of PIN 07549-0107 (LT).

Part of the public highway Viking Road, formerly Woodlawn Avenue, on Plan 2706, designated as Part 3 on Plan 66R-19458 in the City of Toronto (formerly the City of Etobicoke) and Province of Ontario is hereby permanently closed as a public highway.
