BY-LAW No. 24-2003

To permanently close a below-grade portion of the public lane west of Yonge Street, extending southerly from Scollard Street, abutting premises Nos. 11 and 21 Scollard Street.

WHEREAS it is recommended that a below-grade portion of the public lane west of Yonge Street, extending southerly from Scollard Street, abutting premises Nos. 11 and 21 Scollard Street, be permanently closed as a public highway and be sold to the abutting owner upon the terms and conditions set out in Clause No. 44 of Toronto East York Community Council Report No. 12, as adopted by City of Toronto Council at its regular meeting held on November 26, 27 and 28, 2002; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said portion of lane was published in a daily newspaper on January 6, 2003, and was posted on the notices page of the City's web site for at least the two week period immediately preceding the Toronto East York Community Council meeting held on January 21, 2003 and no one appeared to address the Toronto East York Community Council;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The below-grade portion of the public lane west of Yonge Street, extending southerly from Scollard Street, abutting premises Nos. 11 and 21 Scollard Street, described as follows:

Part of the public lane on Plan 179 south of Scollard Street designated as Part 1 on Plan 66R-20103 in the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario is hereby permanently closed as a public highway.
