BY-LAW No. 25-2003

**To permanently close the public lane abutting premises No. 9 Davenport Road and
Frank Stollery Parkette.**

WHEREAS it is recommended that the public lane abutting premises No. 9 Davenport Road and Frank Stollery Parkette, be permanently closed as a public highway and be sold to the abutting owner upon the terms and conditions set out in Clause No. 30 of Toronto East York Community Council Report No. 10, as adopted by City of Toronto Council at its meeting held on October 1, 2 and 3, 2002; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said public lane was published in a daily newspaper on January 6, 2003, and was posted on the notices page of the City's web site for at least the two week period immediately preceding the Toronto East York Community Council meeting held on January 21, 2003 and no one appeared to address the Toronto East York Community Council;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The public lane abutting premises No. 9 Davenport Road and Frank Stollery Parkette described as follows:

The public lane on Plan 179 established as a pedestrian walkway by City of Toronto By-law No. 723-84 (CT693412) designated as Parts 1 and 2 on Plan 66R-20056 in the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario is hereby permanently closed as a public highway.
