BY-LAW No. 47-2003

To permanently close the portion of Borough Drive located between Triton Road and Progress Avenue.

WHEREAS it is recommended that the portion of Borough Drive located between Triton Road and Progress Avenue be permanently closed as a public highway and be sold to the abutting owner upon the terms and conditions set out in Clause No. 16 of Administration Committee Report No. 10, as adopted by Council at its Special Meeting held on July 30, 31 and August 1, 2002; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said portion of highway was published in a daily newspaper on January 6, 2003 and was posted on the notices page of the City's web site for two weeks commencing on January 6, 2003 and no one appeared to address the Scarborough Community Council at its meeting held on January 21, 2003;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of Borough Drive located between Triton Road and Progress Avenue, described as follows:

Part of PIN 06000-0208 (LT).

Pcl Streets-1, Pcl 1' Res-1, Sect M1410.

Part of the public highway Borough Drive, being part of Block RX (1' Reserve) dedicated by Corporation of the Borough of Scarborough By-law No. 15752 (A-832669) and part of Borough Drive on Plan M-1410, designated as Part 1 on Plan 66R-20162 in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto (formerly City of Scarborough) and Province of Ontario is hereby permanently closed as a public highway.
