where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Bloor Street East and access/laneway to Eastbound Left Anytime

No. 300 Bloor Street East, located approximately

39 metres west of Mount Pleasant Road
