BY-LAW No. 71-2003

To rename the public highway Candida Gate as “Ravenscroft Circle”.

WHEREAS notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was advertised in a daily newspaper on January 6, 2003, was posted on the City of Toronto web site for two weeks, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on January 21, 2003, and it is appropriate to rename the public highway Candida Gate which connects Burbank Drive with Ravenscroft Circle as “Ravenscroft Circle”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The public highway Candida Gate described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

PIN 10062-0268 (LT).

Parcel 10740, Section East York.

Candida Gate on Plan M-677 in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto (formerly in the City of North York) and Province of Ontario, is renamed Ravenscroft Circle.
