BY-LAW No. 76-2003

To name the public lane 45.6 metres north of Barton Avenue extending westerly from Pendrith Lane as “St. Raymond Heights”.

WHEREAS notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was advertised in a daily newspaper on January 6, 2003, was posted on the City of Toronto web site for two weeks, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on January 21, 2003, and it is appropriate to name the public lane 45.6 metres north of Barton Avenue extending westerly from Pendrith Lane as “St. Raymond Heights”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The public lane 45.6 metres north of Barton Avenue extending westerly from Pendrith Lane, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

The public lane abutting the northerly limit of Lots 103A to 113, inclusive, on Plan 1088 in the Registry Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario is named St. Raymond Heights.
