CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 83-2003

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Bathurst Street (M.T. 19)	West	Dell Park Avenue and Fairholme Avenue	7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. except Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Bathurst Street (M.T. 19)	West	A point 15 metres north of Dell Park Avenue and Fairholme Avenue	7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. Monday to Friday except Public Holidays

2. Schedule IX (No Stopping) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Bathurst Street (M.T. 19)	West	Dell Park Avenue and a point 15 metres north thereof	Anytime

3. Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

Dundas Street West and the access to No. 3487 Dundas Street West, located at the northeast corner of Dundas Street West and Willard Avenue (M.T. 8)	Northbound	Left and Right	Anytime
Dundas Street West and the access to No. 3487 Dundas Street West, located at the northeast corner of Dundas Street West and Willard Avenue (M.T. 8)	Westbound	Left	Anytime
Lake Shore Boulevard West and the driveway to No. 1491 Lake Shore Boulevard West (The Boulevard Club) (M.T. 2)	Westbound	U-Turns	Anytime
