BY-LAW No. 96-2003

To declare the council seat for Ward 30 - Toronto-Danforth vacant.

WHEREAS Councillor Jack Layton has resigned from office by notice in writing filed with the Clerk of the City of Toronto; and

WHEREAS s.259(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that the seat of a member of council becomes vacant if the member resigns from his office; and

WHEREAS s.262 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that, where the seat of a member of a council becomes vacant under s.259, the council shall at its next meeting declare the office to be vacant;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1.** The seat of Councillor, Ward 30 of Toronto-Danforth is hereby declared to be vacant.
