BY-LAW No. 156-2003

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1.** Schedule VIII (No Parking) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Warden Avenue (M.T. 67)	East	A point 250 metres north of St. Clair Avenue East and Comstock Road	Anytime
Warden Avenue (M.T. 67)	West	A point 250 metres north of St. Clair Avenue East and Ashtonbee Road	Anytime

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule by striking out the following words and figures:

Warden Avenue (M.T. 67)	Both	Danforth Avenue and Mack Avenue	7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday to Friday, except Public Holidays
Warden Avenue (M.T. 67)	West	St. Clair Avenue East and Ashtonbee Road	Anytime
Warden Avenue (M.T. 67)	East	St. Clair Avenue East and Comstock Road	Anytime
Warden Avenue (M.T. 67)	Both	A point 152.5 metres south of St. Clair Avenue East and Mack Avenue	Anytime

2. Schedule IX (No Stopping) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Warden Avenue (M.T. 67)	Both	Danforth Avenue and a point 250 metres north of St. Clair Avenue East	Anytime

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule by striking out the words and figures:

Warden Avenue (M.T. 67)	Both	St. Clair Avenue East and a point 152.5 metres south thereof	Anytime
