BY-LAW No. 197-2003

**To amend the City of Toronto Municipal Code, respecting references to
By-law No. 574-2000.**

WHEREAS Schedule "A" to By-law No. 514-2002, "A by-law to adopt a new City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing," is a codified version of By-law No. 574-2000, "Respecting the licensing, regulating and governing of trades, businesses and occupations in the City of Toronto", as amended; and

WHEREAS By-law No. 514-2002 also repealed By-law No. 574-2000 and came into force on January 1, 2003; and

WHEREAS Planning and Transportation Committee Report No. 7, Clause No. 3, authorizes the City Solicitor to prepare and introduce in Council the necessary bills, taking into account any transitional issues, to give effect to the adoption of the new Code Chapter;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by deleting the phrases "Licensing By-law No. 574-2000" and "By-law No. 574-2000" and substituting the phrase "Chapter 545, Licensing, of the Municipal Code" in all cases.
2. This by-law shall be deemed to have come into force on January 1, 2003.
