BY-LAW No. 201-2003

To permanently close portions of the Adelaide Street East road allowance, abutting Premises No. 19 Wilkins Avenue.

WHEREAS it is recommended that the un-travelled portions of the Adelaide Street East road allowance abutting Premises No. 19 Wilkins Avenue be permanently closed as a public highway and be sold to the abutting owner upon the terms and conditions set out in Clause No. 47 of Toronto East York Community Council Report No. 9, as adopted by Council at its Special meeting held on July 30, 31 and August 1, 2002; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said highway was published in a daily newspaper on March 17, 2003, and was posted on the notices page of the City's web site for at least the two week period immediately preceding the Toronto East York Community Council meeting held on April 1, 2003 and no one appeared to address the Toronto East York Community Council;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portions of the Adelaide Street East road allowance, abutting Premises No. 19 Wilkins Avenue, described as follows:

Part of the public highway, Adelaide Street, comprising part of Block A, Roman Catholic Church Block on the south side of Queen Street according to Plan 108 the said part of Adelaide Street being dedicated for public highway purposes by Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 97-74 (CT77753), designated as Parts 1, 2 and 3 on Plan 66R-19799, City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, Land Registry Office for the Registry Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) are hereby permanently closed as a public highway.
