BY-LAW No. 221-2003

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VI (Prohibited Pedestrian Crossings) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)
Lawrence Avenue West (M.T. 22)	Between the west curb line of Blossomfield Drive and a point 30.5 metres east of the east curb line of Blossomfield Drive

2. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)	(In Column 5)
Lawrence Avenue West and Blossomfield Drive (M.T. 22)	Lawrence Avenue West and a point 30.5 metres north thereof	Easterly Southbound	Anytime	Southbound left-turning
Lawrence Avenue West and Blossomfield Drive (M.T. 22)	Lawrence Avenue West and a point 30.5 metres north thereof	Westerly Southbound	Anytime	Southbound left-turning, Southbound right-turning
