BY-LAW No. 242-2003

To amend By-law No. 29704, a by-law respecting fire routes in the geographic area of North York, a by-law of the former City of North York.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the *City of Toronto Act*, 1997, S.O. 1997, c. 2, every by-law or resolution of an old council that is in force immediately before January 1, 1998 is deemed to be a by-law or resolution of the Council of the City of Toronto and remains in force, in respect of the part of the urban area to which it applied immediately before January 1, 1998, until the Council repeals it or amends it to provide otherwise; and

WHEREAS By-law No. 29704 of the former City of North York, as amended, provides for the inclusion of locations in the former North York as designated fire routes where such locations meet the requirements of that By-law; and

WHEREAS By-law No. 29704 was in force in the former North York immediately before January 1, 1998 and has not been repealed or amended to provide otherwise by the Council of the City of Toronto; and

WHEREAS the Fire Chief is satisfied that locations described below meet the requirements of By-law No. 29704 for inclusion of those locations as designated fire routes;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Schedule "B" of By-law No. 29704 of the former City of North York, now a by-law of the City of Toronto, is further amended by adding the following locations:
 - (a) Application No. 2002-002

80 - 100 Ellerslie Avenue and

20 - 56 McBride Lane

thereby including those locations as designated fire routes within the meaning of the By-law.
