**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 245-2003**

**To permanently close a portion of the public lane at the rear of 6 Vermont Avenue.**

WHEREAS it is recommended that a portion of the public lane at the rear of 6 Vermont Avenue be permanently closed as a public highway and be sold to the abutting owner upon the terms and conditions set out in Clause No. 45 of Toronto East York Community Council Report No. 12, as adopted by Council at its regular meeting held on November 26, 27 and 28, 2002; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said portion of lane was published in a daily newspaper on March 17, 2003, and was posted on the notices page of the City's web site for at least the two week period immediately preceding the Toronto East York Community Council meeting held on April 1, 2003 and no one appeared to address the Toronto East York Community Council;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of the public lane at the rear of 6 Vermont Avenue, described as follows:

Part of PIN 21258-0412 (LT).

Being part of the Lane on Plan 745 North West Annex designated as Part 1 on Plan 66R-20249 in the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario is hereby permanently closed as a public highway.
