## CITY OF TORONTO

## BY-LAW No. 258-2003

## To expropriate certain land for the establishment of a public lane at the rear of Premises Nos. 26 to 36 Vaughan Road.

WHEREAS notice of an application to the Council of the City of Toronto for approval to expropriate the land hereinafter described for public lane purposes has been served on the registered owners thereof and has been published pursuant to the provisions of the *Expropriations Act*; and

WHEREAS no notice in writing of a desire for a hearing has been received with respect to such land and the time for giving such notice has expired;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The expropriation of the interests in land described in section 2 hereof is hereby approved.
- 2. The fee simple interest and all other right, title and interest in the land described as PIN 21261-0603 (LT), being part of Lot 59, Plan 1306, designated as Part 1 on Plan 64R-16930, City of Toronto, is hereby expropriated and taken for public lane purposes and for all works and uses ancillary thereto pursuant to the provisions of the *Municipal Act*, 2001.
- 3. Authority is hereby granted for the signing, sealing and registration in the proper Land Registry Office of the plans showing the lands expropriated pursuant to section 2 hereof, including the payment of all expenses incidental thereto.
- 4. The Director of Real Estate Services is hereby authorized to sign, and serve on the registered owners of the interests in land described in section 2 hereof, the Notices of Expropriation, the Notices of Election as to a Date for Compensation and the Notices of Possession as contemplated by the *Expropriations Act*.
- The Mayor and the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to this by-law and the City Clerk and the Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer are hereby directed to execute all documents necessary in that behalf, and the Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer is authorized and directed to affix the corporate seal of the City to all such documents.
